Safety Concerns in Prison or Jail

Updated March 2023

Note: We prepared the following information as a general guide. We tried to use the most up to date information, but we cannot guarantee everything here is current or accurate for your situation. This handout is general information only and does not constitute legal advice, nor create a lawyer-client relationship between you and Texas Civil Rights Project. We encourage you to contact a lawyer if you wish to file a lawsuit. If you write to us, we can send a lawyer referral list.

We are sorry to hear about your safety concerns. There are steps you can take depending on your situation. You can contact these people from prison or jail or a family member or friend can send a complaint. These steps are specific to TDCJ prisons, but county jails should have a similar process:

- File a grievance: Fill out a grievance form (I-27). List who is making you feel unsafe and why. Write what you need to help you feel safe. The Prison Litigation Reform Act (a federal law) requires you to file Step 1 and Step 2 grievances before you file a lawsuit. You may be barred from taking your problems to court if you do not file grievances and any available appeals. If you want more information about filing grievances, we can send it to you.
- Contact the unit major: Send an I-60 form to the major on your unit. Try to keep a copy of the I-60 to show you requested help. Write down who or what is making you feel unsafe.
- Contact the Safe Prisons/PREA Program: Write to the Safe Prisons Program. Write who is threatening you and why you do not feel safe. You should write to them if you or someone else has experienced sexual assault or abuse:
